

## E-Mailing the Applications for AJAS

### **For Seniors who presented papers at FJAS during their Junior year.**

FJAS members who competed and placed with experimental papers during their junior year of high school are eligible to apply for a scholarship to present at the American Junior Academy of Science (AJAS) and American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) conference held each year in mid February and AAAS membership. These applications should be e-mailed by **September 1<sup>st</sup> of their senior year.**

FJAS members wanting to attend and present at AJAS/AAAS at their own expense may apply for nomination only.

The application is preferred by email but can be mailed. The application **MUST** have the following information in the text of the e-mail:

**Resume of science research activities during high school (not to exceed 2 pages)**

**Abstract of paper presented at FJAS your Junior year**

**Plans for research during the senior year ( a minimum of a proposal and time line of completion of experimentation - not competitions)**

**Plans for the presentation at AJAS (Junior paper or Senior paper)**
